Independence Day



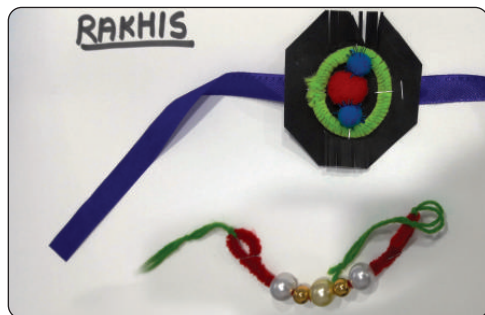
