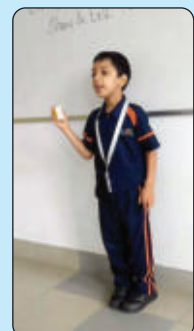
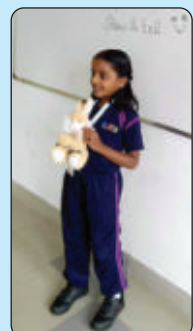
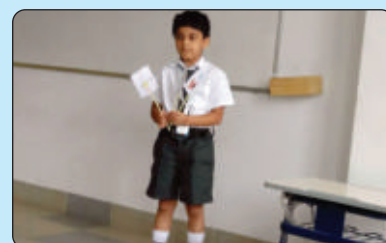


ENGLISH WEEK 27th to 30th June 2017
