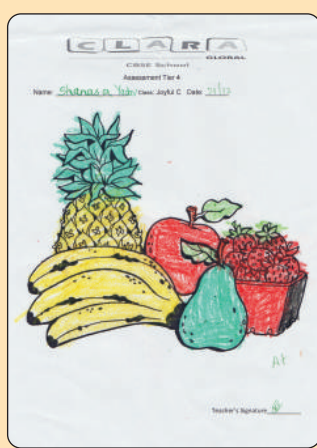
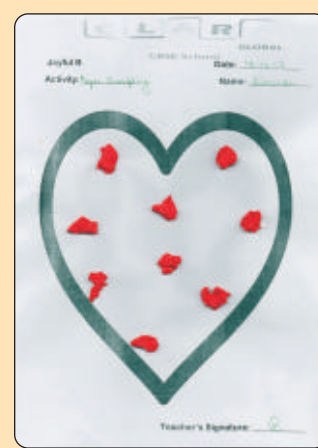


Logiqids and Olympiad exams

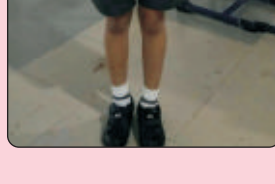
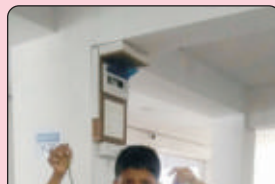


PRE-PRIMARY

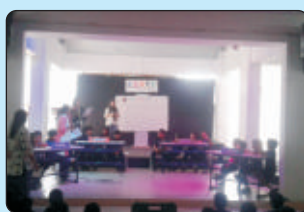
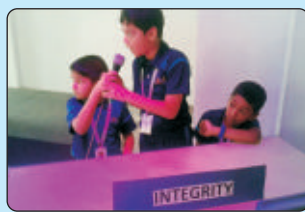
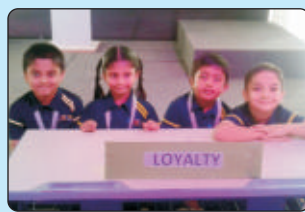


WORLD SCIENCE DAY

There was a lot of cheering and the auditorium rang with the sound of their hearty shouts of encouragement.



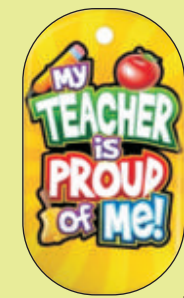
GRANDPARENTS DAY
