proud of the fact that apart from Academics, there has been Dance, Music, Sports, Art classes, elocution and singing competitions, etc. from day one of the lockdown.

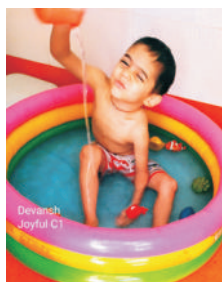

One of the issues was “non-payment of fees by parents in different parts of the country leading to the face-off between parents and the school management and teachers and the subsequent shut down of 1400 schools and online teaching in Maharashtra on 15, 16 and 17th of December as a result due to non-payment of fees”. Ekta Ma'am held her own by stating that even as her heart goes out to the students, she would like to stand with her Teacher Fraternity who have not backed down from their dedication, commitment to the cause in spite of getting only 50% -70% of their salary only because parents are not paying their fees on time. They have done their best to provide education to their students from day one of the lockdown and given their 100%. Teachers who are not tech savvy have learned to deliver online and have done an amazing and satisfying job all these nine months. The School Management has given parents waivers and made allowances for fees to be paid on a monthly basis etc. but there are still parents who have not paid the fees.

Speaking for Clara Global, we hope and pray that the issue is soon resolved so that schools will continue to shape leaders of the future and inspire future generations both on a local as well as global scale.

19th June 2020

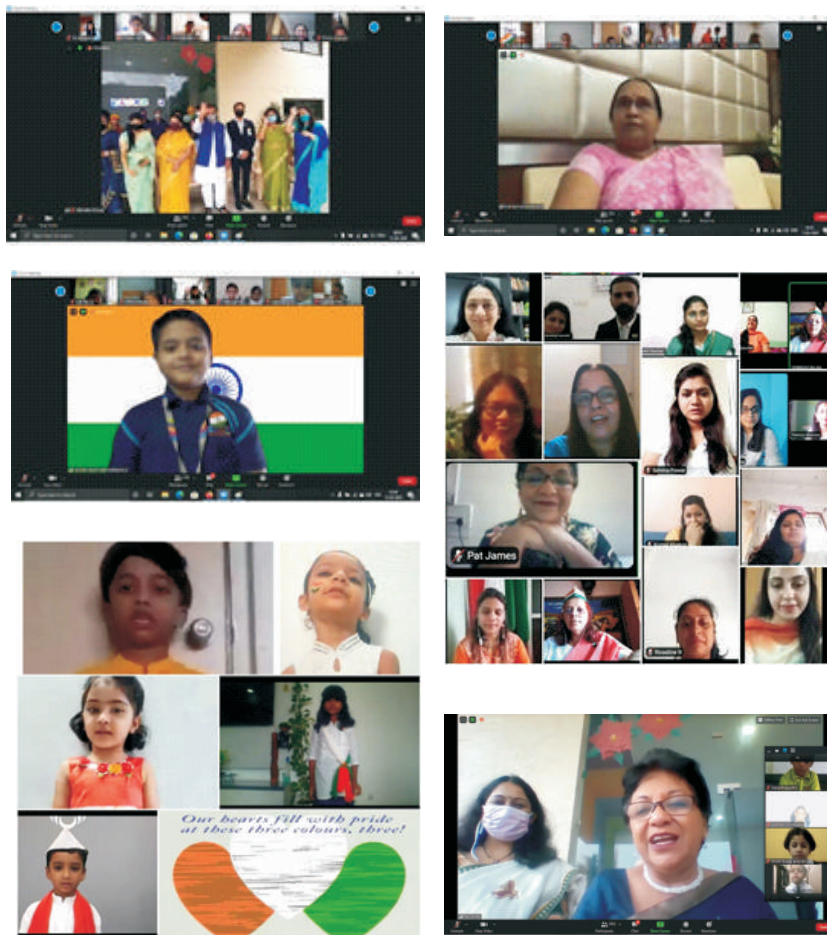

Rebuttals were excellent and winners were as follows:

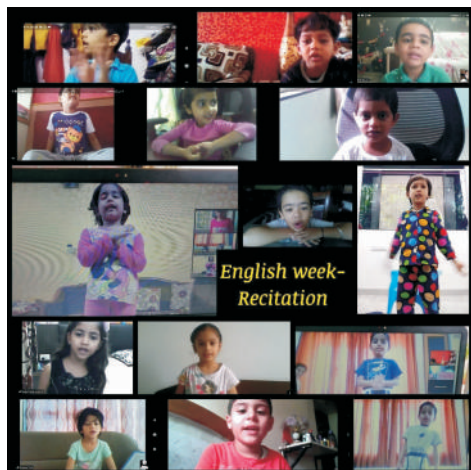
Inspiring B: Team A who were FOR the argument "Is the computer a boon or a bane" won with best Debater: Shivi Gupta

Students like Dakshita Gupta, Ayan Atmakuri, Mahi, Gayatri Mishra,

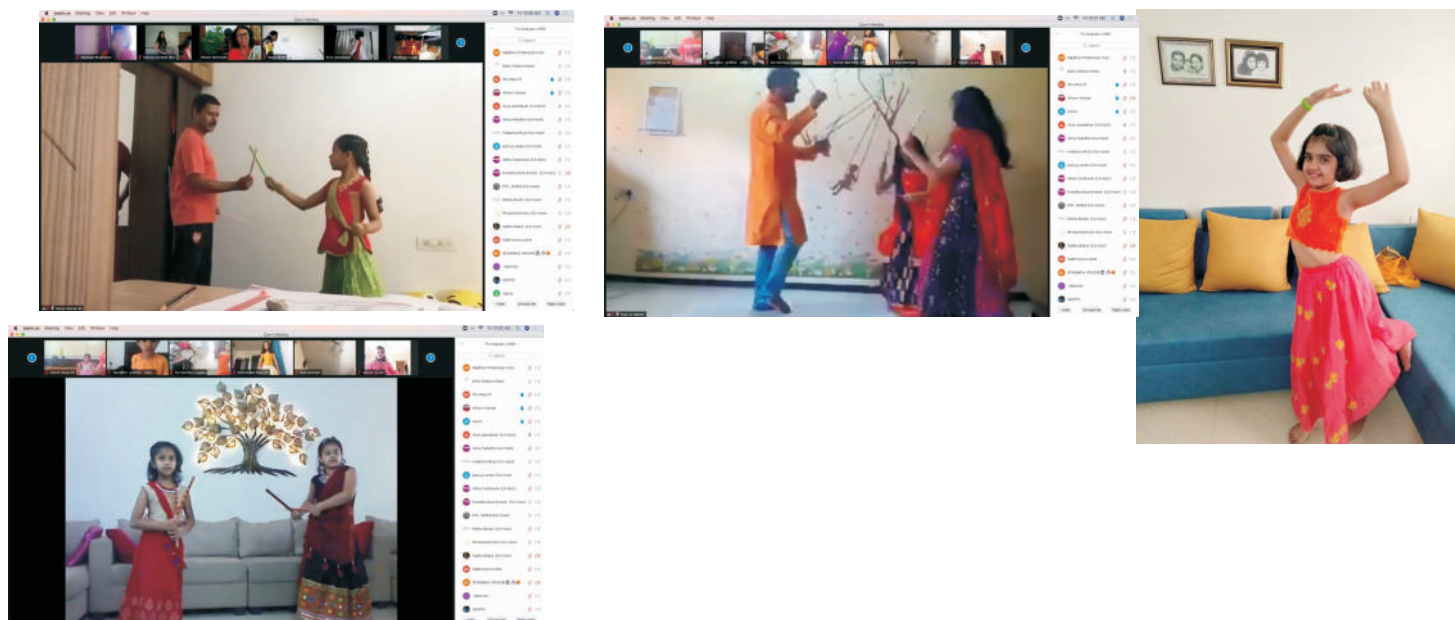
Pratik Patil, Arnav Babar, Stephen Rajmohan and Nihil Nambiar were excellent and articulated their viewpoints well.

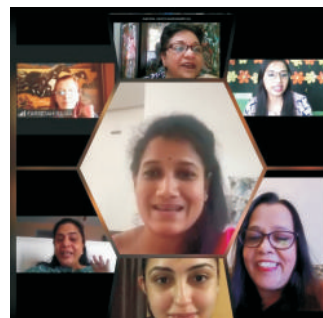
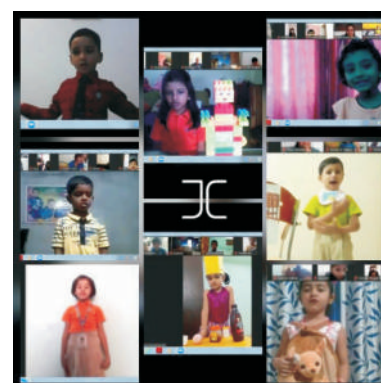
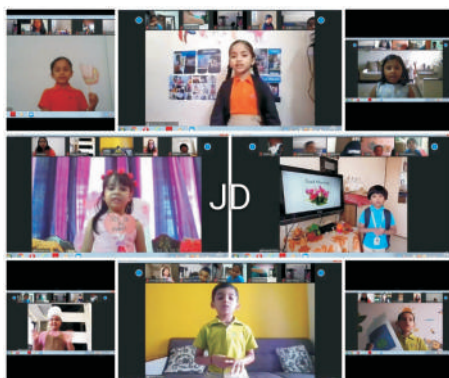
GRANDPARENTS DAY

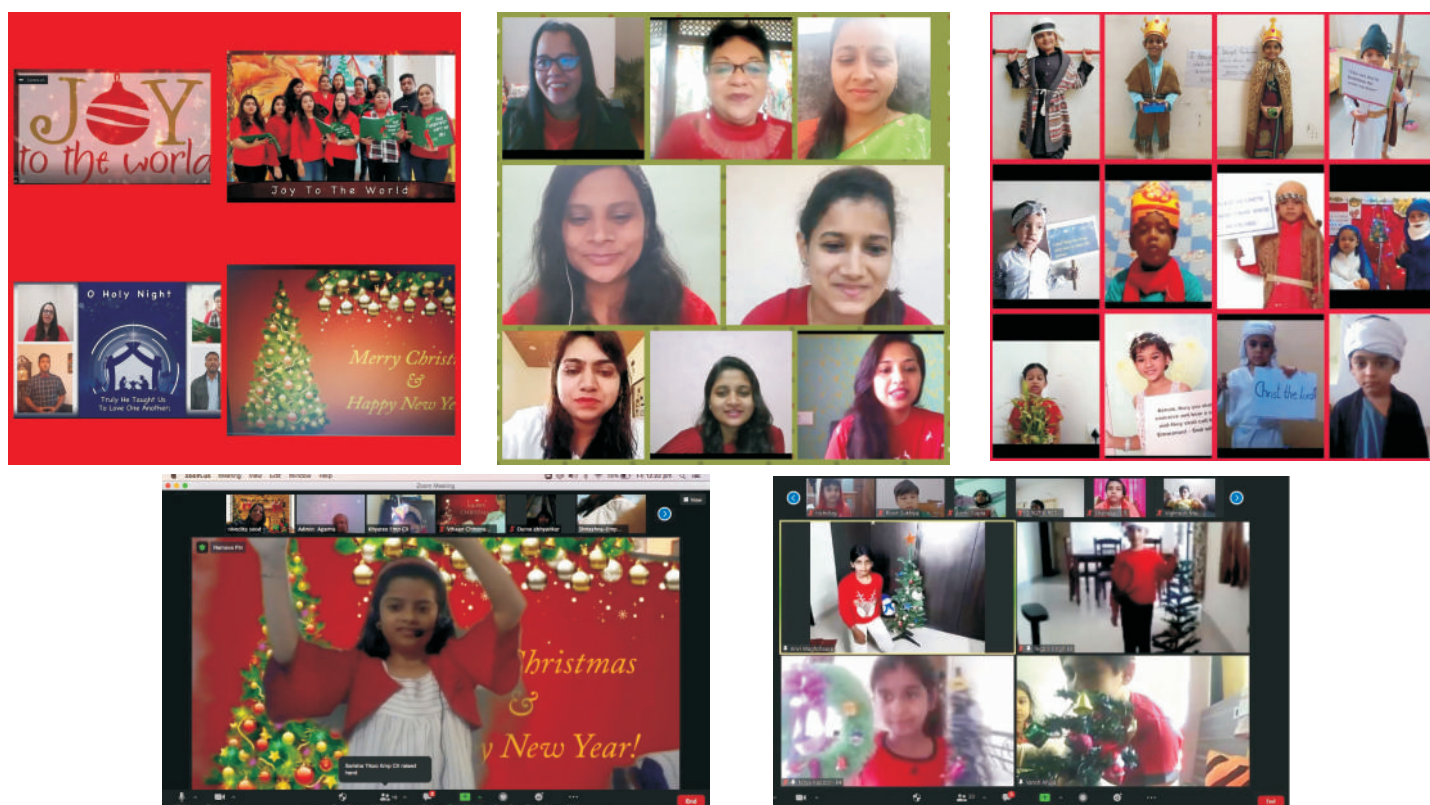

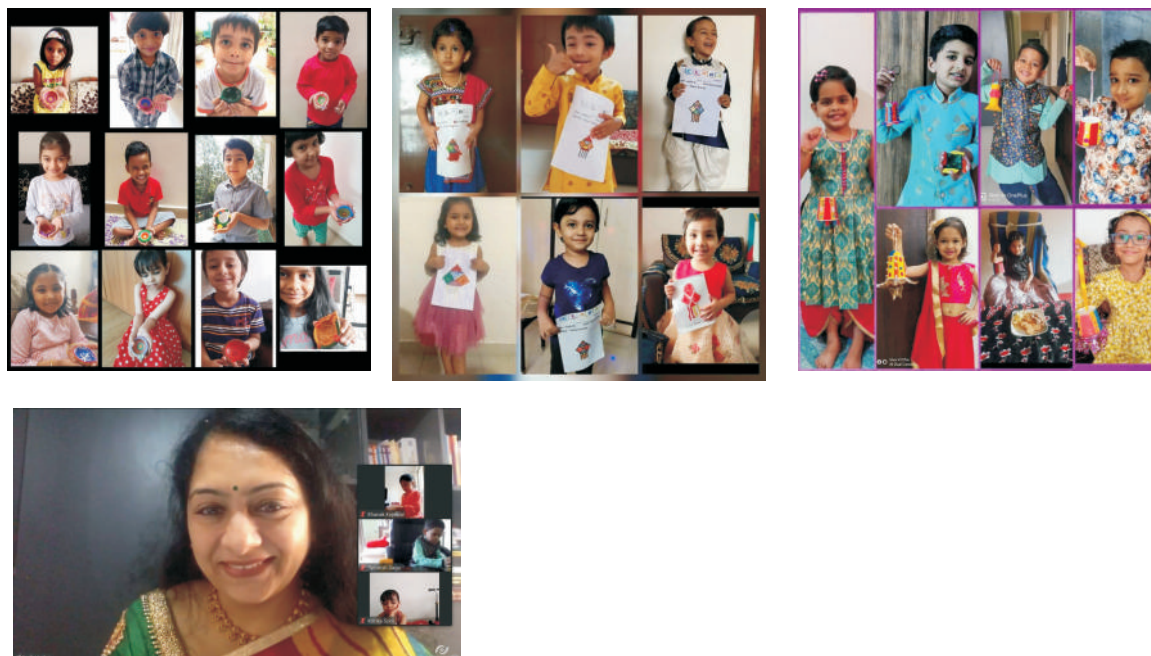
As we came towards the end of the program, Tanushree ma'am gave the vote of thanks.

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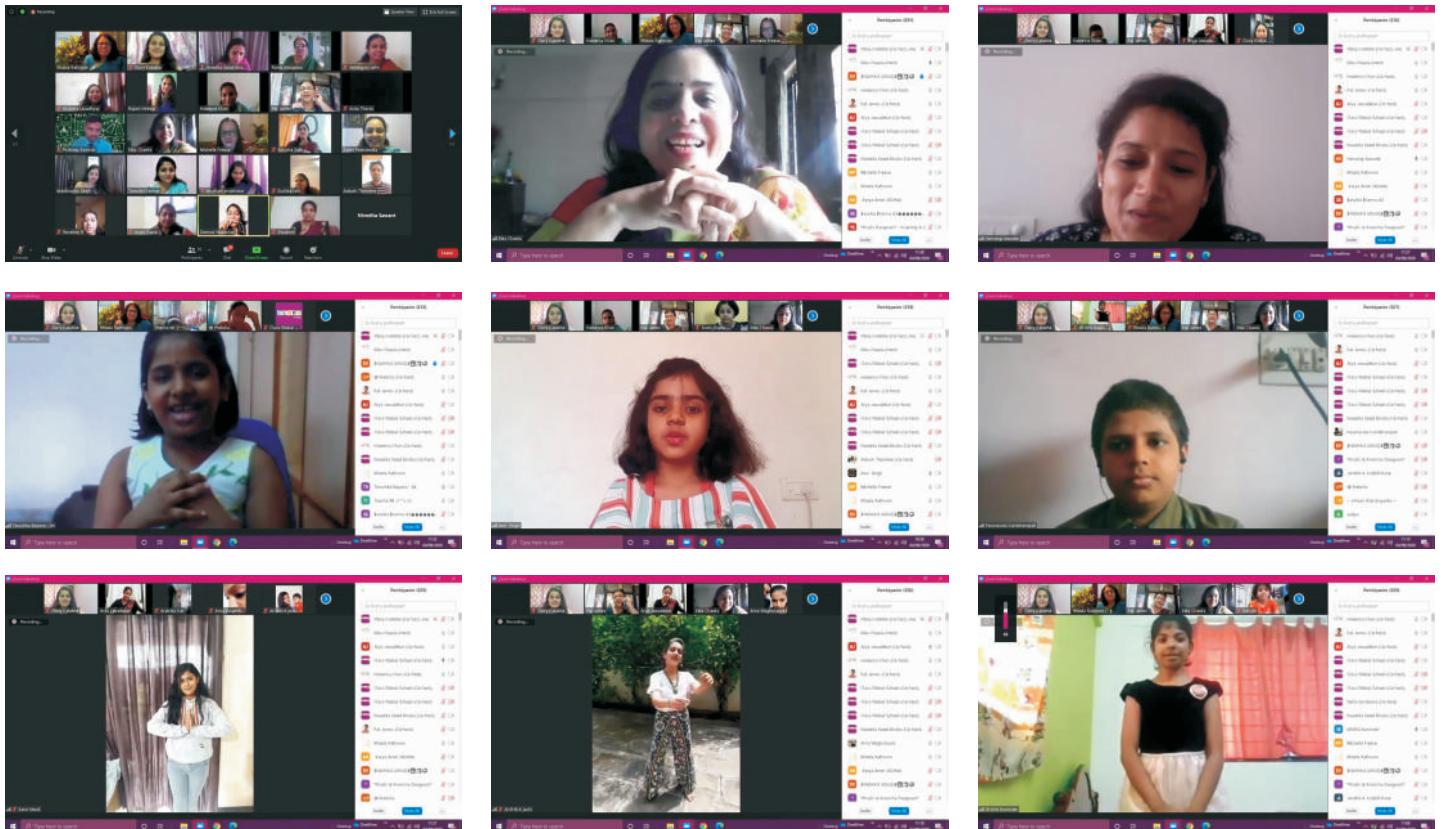
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CLARA AND COMSENSE JOIN HANDS TO HELP!
