PRIMARY FIELD TRIP

5th December 2021

The Primary Section of Clara Global School enjoyed a virtual field trip to the Mojave Desert situated in one of the harshest and deadliest environments on planet earth. Not only did they learn about the extreme climate of this desert but they were fascinated by the number of animal species and plant species found there!

The children also learnt about SERICULTURE - the process of cultivating silk worms and extracting the silk fibre from them. Right from the stage when the farmer cultivates a fertile piece of land to plant the mulberry gardens to the various development stages of the silk moth - caterpillar, larva, pupa and adult silk moth, the students were captivated by this amazing little creature who gives us fine, strong and lustrous silk. The students answered quiz questions on sericulture as well as the Mojave Desert. Facts like we can get 1 km of silk filament from a single cocoon; spinning racks called Chandrike are used to help the pupa spin their cocoons, an adult female moth can lay 300 to 500 eggs and that the eggs turn blue in colour just before hatching kept the students spellbound.









PRE PRIMARY FIELD TRIP

6th December 2021



The Pre Primary section of Clara Global School enjoyed a virtual field trip to the Arctic! Students learned about the fascinating animals that live in the freezing cold place in the North Pole. From the POLAR BEAR to the mighty ORCA, the facts about these animals kept the students mesmerized. 





