SENSORY EXPLORATION



The year started with a bang as students right from Nursery in the Joyful Section to the Senior Section looked forward to an exciting Academic Year.

On 12th April 2024, **Sensory Exploration** by discovering textures was conducted for the students of the Joyful Section.(Nursery to Upper Kindergarten)

Engaging children in sensorial activities is a fantastic way to stimulate their growing minds and senses. In this activity, the children had the opportunity to explore different textures, such as hard, soft, rough, and smooth, through hands-on experiences. This tactile exploration will not only enhance their sensory perception but also promote language development and cognitive skills. Materials like stones leaves, sand, sponge, grass etc were used for the activity.

Sorting trays with the different textures were placed for the activity and the teachers explained to the students to use their feet to explore the sense of touch for different textures.

The children were encouraged to describe how the object feels (e.g., Is it hard or soft? Is it rough or smooth?).

Once the child explored the texture, they were guided to place their feet in a tray of paint for footprints to gather their experience and observations of the sensorial activity.

Descriptive words helped them to express their thoughts while vocabulary related to textures was reinforced.

This celebration highlighted Clara Global School's commitment to promoting health and holistic education.






MUD DAY

We believe that these conversations are crucial in shaping a safe and supportive environment for all our students. A big thank you to our speakers for their valuable insights and guidance!




BATTLING CLIMATE CHANGE

28th July 2023




parents and faculty alike.
